Fri, Nov 27th, 2009 at 9:00 PM.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> · New entries & registrations due. Registration fees and judge burdens are frozen. Yes, I know this is the Friday after Thanksgiving. The trouble is, at tournaments with caps, sometimes schools will sit on “entry slots” until the deadline and drop at the very last minute. So I’ve extended the registration freeze date forward, to encourage you to drop unneeded slots in time so that students who would definitely like to come and are on the wait list have time to make arrangements to attend. Please make final arrangements & commitments before the Thanksgiving break.

Mon, Nov 30th at noon	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> · LD judge strikes & ratings can be entered online. Judge strikes entered online will be guaranteed throughout the tournament; judge strikes can also be made at registration but strikes submitted then will not be guaranteed until round 3
Thu, Dec 3rd at 9:00 PM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> · LD judge strikes & ratings due for those using online entry · All other division’s judge names & information due. We will likely run out of hired judges long before this; be sure to request hired judges early. · Drops can no longer be made online, but must be emailed to princeton@tabroom.com. \$10 nuisance fines in addition to registration fees for each drop made after this time.
Fri, Dec 4th 2:30-4:00 PM	<p>Debate Onsite Registration. Debate drops will be fined \$15 after 2:30. Schools with debaters must register by 4:00 PM, whether or not they have changes. Please do not come to registration early; we’ll still be setting everything up.</p>
Fri, Dec 4th 7:30-8:30 PM	<p>Speech & Congress Only Registration. You can register in person, or call in to the tournament number: (617) 981-2754. You must register to check in whether or not you have any changes. Schools that call in should pay their registration fees on Saturday morning at tab during the first round of competition. Please do not come to registration early; that hampers our setup and our debate tabbing.</p>

We will release a tournament schedule on <http://princeton.tabroom.com> by Nov 1st; 2 preset Debate rounds will run Friday night (LD and PF) while Speech and Congress will run exclusively on Saturday and Sunday. Friday rounds will not begin prior to 5PM, and the awards ceremony on Sunday should end by 3:30 PM on Sunday.
