

A Bill Regarding Pakistan

1. Be it enacted by this Congress:
2. All foreign aid to Pakistan will be rescinded until
3. in the opinion of the Secretary of State, Pakistan resumes its assistance
4. to the United States in the war in Afghanistan.
5. This bill will take effect immediately.

A Resolution Regarding Immigration

1. Whereas the United States is a country founded upon immigrants and
2. Whereas the United States has benefited from the contributions of immigrants and
3. Whereas those who are here illegally have become an essential part of our economy.
4. Therefore be it resolved that
5. Congress shall construct a procedure whereby those who have been living in the
6. United States for at least 5 years without being convicted of a crime may be
7. offered an opportunity to receive citizenship.

A Bill Chinese Imports

1. Section 1: A 20% tariff will be imposed upon all imports from China.
2. Section 2: Revenues from this tariff will be used to aid in rebuilding infrastructure
3. in the United States and to retraining unemployed American workers.
4. Section 3: This bill will go into effect on January 1, 2012.
5. Section 4: All laws contradicting this law will be void.

A Resolution to privatize Amtrak

1. Whereas Amtrak has lost money over the years and
2. Whereas usage of certain lines has been cost inefficient and
3. Whereas the current system makes it impossible to implement a
4. high speed train system.
5. Therefore be it resolved that
6. The Amtrak system will be privatized and receive no further
7. subsidies.

A Resolution to Join the International Criminal Court

1. Whereas the United Nations has established itself as a world body and
2. Whereas the United States should remain a leader in bringing justice to the world and
3. Whereas the United States' refusal to join the International Criminal Court hurts its
4. standing in the world and
5. Whereas it is hypocritical to condemn the war crimes of other world leaders while the
6. United States refuses to submit to the same justice system.
7. Therefore be it resolved that the United States shall join the International
8. Criminal Court.
